

Indoor Materials List

Material List:

Paints, Watercolor, Acrylic or Oil: Titanium White, Ivory Black, Cadmium Yellow Medium, Yellow Oxide or Ochre, , Burnt & Raw Sienna., Cadmium Orange, Cadmium Red Light and Medium, Alizarin Crimson, Viridian Green or *Pythalo Green*, Cerulean Blue, Cobalt Blue and or *Ultramarine Blue*, *Pythalo Blue*

Mediums for oils:

Poppy oil, Walnut oil or Linseed oil.

Brushes: (White Bristle) Filberts, Flats and Rounds # 4, #8=2 0& #12 or larger.

Canvases: Bring a variety of canvases measuring, 9"x12", 12 x 16", 16" x 20" or larger. (18" x 24" & 24" x 36' are preferable). During most classes and workshops, students produce 1- 3 paintings a day, so please bring a variety of sizes of canvases.. primed masonite panels are acceptable.

Equipment: 11" x 14" or larger Palette, Scraping Knife, 11" x 14" or larger Sketchbook, Compressed Charcoal, Pencils, Erasers. Optional: Watercolors, Gouache and brushes, Folding Chair, Umbrella, Hat, Sunscreen, Bug off, Bungee cords, tape, Water or mineral container, drop cloth . **Odorless Mineral Spirits**, *we cannot use turpentine or any other solvent that releases fumes. (Gamsol recommended).*

Paints, Acrylic or Oil:

Burnt Sienna., Titanium White, Ivory Black, Cadmium Yellow, Yellow Oxide or Ochre, Cadmium Orange, Cadmium Red Light and Medium, Alizarin Crimson, Viridian Green or *Pythalo Green*, Cerulean Blue, Cobalt Blue and or *Ultramarine Blue*, *Pythalo Blue*, Optional: Watercolors, Gouache and brushes,

Mediums for oils:

Poppy oil , Walnut oil or Linseed oil, Retarder for acrylics

Brushes: Filberts, Flats and Rounds # 4, #8 & #12 or larger. Recommended bushes: white bristle flats... Titanium by Robert Simmons is a good synthetic brush for oils and acrylics.

Canvases: Bring a variety of canvases measuring, 9"x12" or larger. (16" x 20" preferable). During most classes, students produce 1- 2 paintings a day, so please bring a variety of sizes of canvases...working on larger surfaces, I would recommend 24" x 30" or 24" x 36". Massonite (Standard Hardboard) is the cheapest surface, but it needs priming with Gesso. Home Depot will cut it for you.

Equipment: 11" x 14" or larger Palette, 11" x 14" or larger Sketchbook, Compressed Charcoal, Pencils, Erasers. Folding Chair, Sun Umbrella, Hat, Sunscreen, Bug off, Bungee cords, tape, Water or mineral container, drop cloth, Easel . **Odorless Mineral Spirits**, *we cannot use turpentine or any other solvent that releases fumes indoors. (Gamsol or turpenoid recommended).* (Gum Spirits of Turpentine from an art store, if you are not bothered by the fumes).

Please drink plenty of water, and watch for cars. In case of inclement weather with the threat of thunder or lightning, seek safe shelter, but not under trees...
