During her residency, she will be demonstrating how these paints work, allowing her to mimic some features of both watercolor and oil painting. Paintings and sketches from recent travels to Maine, California, France, Mexico and the Bahamas will be on exhibit along with recent work done closer to home. She is looking forward to sharing information and ideas about travel and painting with other artists who stop by the Stone Tower, as well as with visitors who are interested in observing an artist at work.
