Landscape artist Barbara French Pace will demonstrate her painting techniques in the Yellow Barn's Stone Tower Studio at Glen Echo during the month of July. Working primarily in oil, she will alternate with acrylics, pastel, and conte to illustrate a range of media. Visitors are welcome to watch a practicing artist at work and ask questions. A wide range of the artist's paintings and photographs will be on exhibit. Art talks on Sundays will include remarks on the challenges and benefits of working from photographic reference material.

Pace has studied at the Florence Academy of Art in Italy, the Yellow Barn and the Smithsonian in Washington, and workshops here and abroad. She refines her style by painting from the masters at the National Gallery of Art.
