A special thank you should be given to all our members of the Yellow Barn community for supporting this worthwhile endeavor through their generous donations.

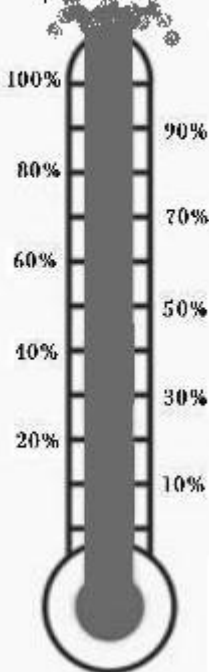
